



## Key Benefits (continued)

- ▶ The UAM architecture enables all security information to be located in a single, central database instead of scattered across a network in several different devices. This approach increases security; a centralized network running RADIUS is much easier to secure than several communications servers located throughout a network.
  - ▶ Controlled device access through RADIUS authentication prevents random and malicious access to critical networks assets.
  - ▶ IMC UAM creates a single, centrally located database of users and available services, a feature particularly important for networks that include more than one remote communications server and access device.
- With it, user information is stored in one location—the RADIUS component—which manages user authentication and access to services from one location.
- ▶ LDAP support enables IMC UAM to leverage user information from existing compliant sources to reduce the time needed to set up users for authentication. It also enables existing directories to be the single repository for user data.
  - ▶ Topology view of access services provides immediate visualization of the access infrastructure and online users. This provides an intuitive tool for monitoring and managing access systems and users, speeding time to deployment and problem resolution.
